4	(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary of Veterans Af-

6	(1) purchase or develop for the Veterans Health
7	Administration an information technology system for

11	(b) PILOT.—If the Secretary purchases or develops
12	a system under subsection (a), the Secretary shall carry
13	out a pilot program at one Department of Veterans Affairs
14	facility before implementing the system throughout the
15	Department. The pilot program shall be designed to deter-
16	mine whether the functions of the system are satisfactory.
17	(c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is

20 (d) DEADLINE.—If the Secretary purchases or develops a system under subsection (a), the Secretary shall 21 complete the implementation of the system by not later 22 than three years after the date of the enactment of this 23 24 Act.
