Add at the end of the bill the following:

1	SEC INDEPENDENT STUDY REGARDING MANAGE-
2	MENT STRUCTURES OF DEPARTMENT OF
3	VETERANS AFFAIRS.
4	(a) In General.—Not later than 90 days after the
5	date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Vet-
6	erans Affairs shall seek to enter into an agreement with
7	the National Academy of Public Administration (referred
8	to in this section as the "Academy") under which the
9	Academy shall conduct a study and review of the over-
10	sight, accountability, and performance management struc-
11	tures of the Department of Veterans Affairs.
12	(b) Considerations.—In conducting a study and
13	review under this section, the Academy shall—
14	(1) consult with the Secretary and outside
15	stakeholders;
16	(2) take into account previous reports and rec-
17	ommendations pertaining to oversight, account-
18	ability, and performance management of the Depart-
19	ment;

1	(3) examine alternatives and develop rec-
2	ommendations for improving the oversight, account-
3	ability, and performance management of the Depart-
4	ment; and
5	(4) make recommendations to improve the over-
6	sight, accountability, and performance management
7	of the Department.
8	(c) Scope.—The scope of the study and review under
9	this section shall include—
10	(1) the organizational structure of the Depart-
11	ment;
12	(2) the employee performance management
13	processes of the Department;
14	(3) training on performance management proc-
15	esses for employees, supervisors, senior executives,
16	and human resources professionals of the Depart-
17	ment;
18	(4) employee professional development pro-
19	grams of the Department; and
20	(5) leadership development programs of the De-
21	partment.
22	(d) Best Practices.—In conducting the study, the
23	Academy shall review best practices of other Federal agen-
24	cies to determine whether they are applicable to the De-
25	partment.

1	(e) Report of the Academy.—Not later than 18
2	months after the date of the enactment of this Act, the
3	Academy shall submit to the Committees on Veterans' Af-
4	fairs of the Senate and House of Representatives a report
5	that contains—
6	(1) the findings of the study and review con-
7	ducted under this section; and
8	(2) any other recommendations that the Acad-
9	emy determines necessary and relevant to the study
10	and review.
11	(f) Report of the Secretary.—Not later than 90
12	days after the Academy submits the report under sub-
13	section (e), the Secretary shall submit to the Committees
14	on Veterans' Affairs of the Senate and House of Rep-
15	resentatives a report containing—
16	(1) the evaluation of the Secretary of the find-
17	ings and recommendations made by the Academy;
18	(2) the determination of the Secretary whether
19	to implement such recommendations and findings;
20	(3) a timeline for such implementation; and
21	(4) the determination of the Secretary whether
22	such implementation requires legislation.
