

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE  
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 1815  
OFFERED BY MR. TAKANO OF CALIFORNIA**

Page 5, line 19, in the matter to be inserted, strike “The” and insert “(A) Subject to subparagraph (B), the”.

Page 5, after line 23, in the matter to be inserted, insert the following new subparagraph:

1       “(B) In the case of an individual who failed to make  
2 a payment on a loan guaranteed under this chapter during  
3 the period beginning on March 1, 2020 and ending on May  
4 1, 2025, the amount of a partial claim under this section  
5 may not exceed 30 percent of the unpaid principal balance  
6 of the guaranteed loan as of the date that the initial par-  
7 tial claim is made.”.

Page 5, line 24, in the matter to be inserted, strike “The” and insert “(A) Subject to subparagraph (B), the”.

Page 6, before line 1, in the matter to be inserted, insert the following new subparagraph:

1 “(B) The Secretary may make an additional partial  
2 claim on a loan guaranteed under this chapter in the case  
3 of an individual who failed to make a payment on such  
4 loan during—

5 “(i) a major disaster declared by the President  
6 under section 401 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster  
7 Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C.  
8 5170); or

9 “(ii) the period of 120 days following such a  
10 major disaster.”.

At the end of the bill, add the following new section:

11 **SEC. 5. INCREASE OF AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIA-**  
12 **TIONS FOR COMPREHENSIVE SERVICE PRO-**  
13 **GRAMS FOR HOMELESS VETERANS.**

14 Section 2016 of title 38, United States Code, is  
15 amended—

16 (1) in paragraph (7), by striking “fiscal year  
17 2015 and each subsequent fiscal year” and inserting  
18 “each of fiscal years 2015 through 2024”; and

19 (2) by adding at the end the following new  
20 paragraphs:

21 “(8) \$344,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2025  
22 and 2026.

1           “(9) \$257,700,000 for each fiscal year there-  
2       after.”.
