Over a decade in the military, including his tenure as an AH-64D Apache Helicopter pilot with the esteemed 1st Cavalry Division at Fort Hood, Texas, has finely honed his leadership capabilities. His commendable service, marked by two deployments to Iraq in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom, earned him numerous awards such as the Air Medal, Bronze Star, and Combat Action Badge. Beyond the battlefield, Ross's roles as an Aide-de-Camp at the U.S. Army Combat Readiness and Safety Center and as a Tactical Officer at the United States Military Academy underscore his profound commitment to military ethics and safety. His final Army assignment as the Executive Officer of the Simon Center for the Professional Military Ethic epitomizes his dedication to the core values that guide our veterans toward exemplary professional and personal lives.

Joining Hire Heroes USA in March 2016, Ross immediately set a new standard for excellence. In 2024 Ross transitioned from Chief Operation Officer at Hire Heroes USA upon his selection as the lead the organization during a pivotal time.
