- 9 graph (2), for cases remanded to the Board by the Court
- 10 of Appeals for Veterans Claims, the evidentiary record be-
- 11 fore the Board shall be limited to the evidence previously
- 12 considered by the Board in such case.
- 13 "(2) The evidentiary record before the Board for
- 14 cases described in paragraph (1) shall include evidence
- 15 submitted by the appellant and his or her representative,
- 16 if any, within 90 days following such remand, which the
- 17 Board shall consider in the first instance.".
