Jon Retzer, a veteran of the U.S. Army and Army National Guard, was appointed Assistant National Legislative Director of the more than 1 million-member DAV (Disabled American Veterans) in October 2022.

As a member of the national legislative department at DAV National Service and Legislative Headquarters in Washington, D.C., Retzer's responsibilities include advancing legislation and policies critical to disabled veterans and their families.



Retzer's DAV career began in 2003 as a national service officer trainee in St. Paul, Minnesota. He was first promoted to assistant supervisor of the Fort Snelling National Service Office and then to supervisor, where he served until being appointed as Assistant National Service Director at DAV National Service and Legislative Headquarters in August 2017.

Retzer served in the U.S. Army from 1991 to 1995 and continued his service with the Army National Guard until his medical separation in 1999.
