Its primary functions are to provide intuitive care plans, patient engagement tools and automated administration. Curapatient is one of 21 companies to have been certified as FedRamp High, which indicates the highest standard of cybersecurity and government interoperability. CuraPatient also won first prize in a Tech Sprint competition hosted by the National Institute of Artificial Intelligence and was named "The Future of Healthcare."

Prior to CuraPatient, Charles was at Composite Apps, Inc., which specialized in applying Artificial Intelligence and advanced data analytics to compress inefficiencies out of its clients' operations - sectors ranging from defense to entertainment to logistics.
