In her current role, Dr. Tenhula is responsible for directing, coordinating and evaluating the Veterans Health Administration's national Research and Development program with a focus on increasing Veteran access to high quality clinical trials, increasing the real-world impact of VA research and transforming VA data into a national research resource. Before assuming this position, Dr. Tenhula was the Deputy Chief Consultant for Specialty Mental Health / Director of Innovation & Collaboration in VHA. In this role she led VHA's specialized mental health programs, VA's collaboration with other federal agencies on mental health issues and VA's national, award-winning Make the Connection mental



health outreach campaign. Dr. Tenhula is a clinical psychologist with expertise in the development, implementation, and evaluation of psychosocial interventions; cognitive functioning in schizophrenia; vocational rehabilitation; and reducing the stigma associated with seeking mental health treatment. She has published multiple research articles and book chapters in the field of Psychology.
