9	(a) Authorization Period Extended.—
10	(1) In general.—Subsection (a)(3) of section
11.	1703 of title 38, United States Code, is amended—
12	(A) by striking "A covered veteran" and
13	inserting "(A) Except as provided by subpara-
14	graph (B), a covered veteran"; and
15	(B) by adding at the end the following new
16	subparagraph:
17	"(B) In the case of emergency treatment furnished
18	to a covered veteran by a health care provider specified

1	in subsection (c) in the course of care of services author
2	ized under subparagraph (A), the Secretary may retro
3	actively deem such emergency treatment to be authorized
4	under such subparagraph if such covered veteran (or an
5	individual acting on behalf of the covered veteran) or such
6	health care provider submits to the Secretary a notifica
7	tion in such form and containing such information and
8	assurances as the Secretary determines appropriate, ex-
9	cept the Secretary may not require such notification to
10	be submitted earlier than 96 hours after the date on which
11	such health care provider begins to furnish such emer-
12	gency treatment to such covered veteran.".
13	(2) EMERGENCY TREATMENT DEFINED.—Sub-
14	section (o) of such section is amended—
15	(A) by redesignating paragraph (2) as
16	paragraph (3); and
17	(B) by inserting after paragraph (1), the
18	following new paragraph:
19	"(2) The term 'emergency treatment' has the
20	meaning given such term in section 1725 of this
21	title.".
22	(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
23	subsection (a) shall take effect on the date that is one
24	year after the date of the enactment of this Act.
