Mr. Ryan Lilly, MPA, is the Director of the Veterans Integrated Service Network, the VA New England Healthcare System (VISN 1). He is a compassionate, servant leader who holds to the Veterans Health Administration's core principles of a High Reliability healthcare system. He began his VA career as a Presidential Management Intern and has achieved continuous advancements through the VA ranks from Medical Center Finance Officer to Associate Director, Hospital Director, and now regional leader of VISN1.



VISN1 is comprised of eight medical centers, 48 Outpatient Sites of Care, six nursing homes, seven acute psychiatric inpatient units, and 14 Mental Health Residential Rehabilitation Treatment Programs, including two residential homeless treatment centers throughout Massachusetts, Connecticut, Rhode Island, New Hampshire, Vermont, and Maine.

As Network Director, Mr. Lilly manages a budget of \$5 B and oversees 17,000 unique employees. His network is the most highly affiliated network in the VA system with top medical schools and other learning institutions such as Harvard, Yale, Tufts, Dartmouth, Brown, Boston University and more. Mr. Lilly strategically manages one of the largest medical and mental health research portfolios in the nation.
