1	SEC. 2. TIME FRAME FOR EMPLOYMENT OF PARTICIPANTS
2	IN DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS

5	(a) In General.—Section 7616 of title 38, United
6	States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
7	lowing new subsection:
8	"(d) Not later than 90 days after the course comple-
9	tion date of a participant in the Scholarship Program, the
10	Secretary shall ensure that the participant receives a con-
11	tract for employment in the full-time clinical practice of
