Dallas Knight - Biography for Congressional Submission

Dallas Knight is an Army combat veteran, author, and nonprofit founder whose journey spans military service, law enforcement intelligence, corporate technology, and national-level advocacy. She enlisted in the U.S. Army at age 17, serving as a Military Police officer and deploying to Iraq in 2003 as part of Operation Iraqi Freedom. By the age of 20, she was a combat veteran—forever changed by her experiences on the ground and the invisible wounds she brought home.

Following her military service, Dallas served nearly a decade as an Intelligence Analyst with the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department and was appointed to the Nevada High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (NV HIDTA) under the DEA. There, she helped dismantle complex narcotic and organized crime networks, gaining deep insight into the criminal justice system and the strategic gaps within it.

She later transitioned to the private sector, becoming a technology executive in a company known for pioneering patented innovations that support analysts and investigators in law enforcement and national security. Her leadership bridges technology with public safety, driving outcomes that improve workflows, connectivity, and access to data.

Dallas's commitment to justice extends beyond technology. She is a volunteer analyst and mentor with *Skull GamesSolutions*, a nonprofit that unites veteran intelligence professionals to identify human trafficking victims and support law enforcement investigations. One of her most meaningful roles is mentoring trafficking survivors who are now becoming analysts themselves—creating a full-circle impact of healing and empowerment.

In 2023, she published her memoir, *Shattered Reflections: A Female Soldier's Unveiled Truth*, offering an unfiltered look at her deployment and her two-decade journey of survival, silence, and healing. She also launched the *(not so) Average Jane* podcast to provide a platform for other female combat veterans to share their own stories and foster community, awareness, and resilience.

Moved by the widespread lack of gender-specific resources in the VA system, Dallas founded *Operation Juliet* in 2024—a nonprofit dedicated to the holistic healing and empowerment of female veterans. Through retreats, community gatherings, and peer leadership development, the organization offers women a path to reconnect, reset, and rise.

Dallas Knight is a bold, informed voice for change. Her lived experience across military, intelligence, and advocacy sectors makes her uniquely qualified to speak on the systemic gaps affecting female veterans. She now leads a national conversation with passion, precision, and purpose—determined to ensure no woman who served is left unheard or unsupported.
