## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Modernizing Depart5 ment of Veterans Affairs Disability Benefit Question6 naires Act".

## SEC. 2. MODERNIZATION OF DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS DISABILITY BENEFIT QUESTION NAIRES.

4 (a) REQUIREMENT FOR TRANSMISSION OF CERTAIN
5 INFORMATION IN MACHINE-READABLE FORMAT.—

6 (1) REQUIREMENT.—Not later than 180 days 7 after enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall re-8 quire all disability benefit questionnaire data col-9 lected in the course of medical disability examinations made by persons other than employees of the 10 11 Department of Veterans Affairs under section 504 12 of the Veterans Benefits Improvement Act of 1996 13 (Public Law 104–275; 38 U.S.C. 5101 note) to be 14 transmitted to the Department in a machine-readable format. 15

16 (2) ISSUANCE OF STANDARDS.—Not later than
17 90 days after the date of the enactment of this Act,
18 the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall issue stand19 ards for the transmission of disability benefit ques20 tionnaire data in a machine-readable format as re21 quired under paragraph (1).

(3) UPDATES.—In making updates to disability
benefit questionnaires after the date specified in
paragraph (1), the Secretary shall—

25 (A) ensure that the updates are made in a26 manner that allows for the data collected under

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the questionnaires to be in a machine-readable
 format as of the date on which the update goes
 into effect; and

4 (B) not later than 60 days before an up5 date goes into effect, notify the persons con6 ducting medical disability examinations (or the
7 entities employing such persons) described in
8 such paragraph of such updates.

9 (b) Plan for Information Technology System 10 MODIFICATION.—Not later than 180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall submit 11 12 to the Committees on Veterans' Affairs of the Senate and 13 House of Representatives a plan to modify the information technology systems and processes of the Department to 14 enable a non-Department health care professional selected 15 by a claimant to transmit to the Department, in a ma-16 17 chine-readable format, disability benefit questionnaire data, including complete disability benefit questionnaires 18 19 rather than partial questionnaires or individual elements 20 of medical evidence.

(c) PUBLIC AVAILABILITY OF INFORMATION.—The
Secretary shall make publicly available on the internet
website of the Department referred to in section 5101(d)
of title 38, United States Code—

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1	(1) a description of the standards issued under
2	subsection $(a)(2)$ ; and
3	(2) the plan required under subsection (b).
4	(d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:
5	(1) The term "claimant" has the meaning given
6	such term in section 5100 of title 38, United States
7	Code.
8	(2) The term "machine-readable" has the
9	meaning given such term in section $3502(18)$ of title
10	44, United States Code.
