


Department of Veterans Affairs Senior Executive Biography

Lewis Ratchford Jr. Chief Security Officer, Office of Operations, Security and Preparedness

Mr. Lewis Ratchford serves as the Chief Security Officer for the Office of Operations, Security and Preparedness, Department of Veterans Affairs. In this capacity, Mr. Ratchford oversees VA's force protection and mission assurance efforts by leading the facilitation and integration of the Department's emergency management response and recovery, personnel security and suitability, and security and law enforcement activities. These efforts aid to prevent and mitigate degradation of VA services to Veterans and employees, as well as to support federal response efforts for incidents and emergencies.





Commissioned Officer in the United States Army (1998 – 2003) and participated in multiple operational deployments to the Balkans and the Middle East. He is a Federal Emergency Management Agency Professional Continuity Practitioner (Level I) and member of the Senior Executive Association (SEA).
