Mr. Andrew Centineo was appointed in December 2021 and oversees Procurement and Logistics support to the Veterans Health Administration. Mr. Centineo is responsible for aligning acquisition, equipment lifecycle management, and healthcare logistics requirements with VHA strategic goals and deliver solutions for VHA's supply chain. With 3,000 employees, the Procurement and Logistics Office is one of VHA's largest staff elements supporting VHA facilities providing acquisition of equipment, services, construction and leasing contracts, integrated healthcare technology programming planning and equipment lifecycle management, and logistics support activities related to VHA commodities and medical-surgical supplies.



Mr. Centineo is a retired U.S. Army Colonel with over 30 years of experience and leadership in healthcare including small and large medical facilities, contingency operations, U.S. Army, Department of Defense, and intragovernmental agency support. Prior to joining the VA in 2018, Mr. Centineo served as Director, Medical Logistics, Defense Health Headquarters where he was responsible for the integration of the Department of Defense's medical logistics compliance, oversight of Joint medical logistics material standardization, and development of Military Health System policies and procedures while establishing a supply chain operating company model for the \$11B Department of Defense medical logistics portfolio.
