

BIOGRAPHY OF GREG NEMBHARD, ASSISTANT DIRECTOR THE AMERICAN LEGION NATIONAL VETERANS AFFAIRS & REHABILITATION DIVISION DISCHARGE UPGRADE CLAIMS



Greg Nembhard is the Assistant Director, Discharge Upgrade Claims in the National Veteran Affairs & Rehabilitation (VA&R) Division of the Washington DC office. Greg is responsible for assisting veterans who are seeking an upgrade to their discharge through the Military Discharge Review Board and the Board for Corrections of Military Records; to include veterans seeking to correct errors in their military record. In this position he is participates in the VA&R resolutions process, discharge upgrade workshops, in-person Board hearings for

veterans, and conduct site visits to local VA Vet Centers to assist veterans seeking a discharge upgrade, correction to their military record, and VA compensation benefits claims assistance. Greg is also responsible for the National Cemetery Committee's portfolio and participates in recommending and reviewing, resolutions, policies, plans, and procedures related to the National Cemetery Administration and assisting Veterans and family members seeking assistance with VA burial benefits.

Greg is a Veteran of both the United State Marine Corps and Army (Reserves) with a combined 15 years of active and reserve service. He served two tours of duty as an active duty Marine, with 2 deployments to Iraq in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom (OIF) I and II. His awards and decorations include the Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal, Combat Action Ribbon, Sea Service Deployment Ribbon (w/1 Star), Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal, National Defense Service Medal, and the Army Reserve Component Achievement Medal.
