1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the " <b>[]</b>
5	Act of 2021".

1	SEC. 2. VETERANS HEALTH ADMINISTRATION AND VET-
2	ERANS BENEFITS ADMINISTRATION COORDI-
3	NATION FOR CERTAIN CLAIMS ARISING
4	FROM MILITARY SEXUAL TRAUMA.
5	(a) Coordinated Provision of Materials.—Dur-
6	ing or immediately after each covered event, and together
7	with each covered document, in a claim for compensation
8	arising from military sexual trauma experienced by a vet-
9	eran, the Under Secretary for Benefits of the Veterans
10	Benefits Administration, in coordination with the Under
11	Secretary for Health of the Veterans Health Administra-
12	tion, shall provide to the veteran—
13	(1) outreach letters;
14	(2) information on the Veterans Crisis Line;
15	(3) information on how to make an appoint-
16	ment with a mental health provider; and
17	(4) other information on available resources re-
18	lating to military sexual trauma (including informa-
19	tion on military sexual trauma coordinators of the
20	Veterans Health Administration, mental health pro-
21	viders trained in military sexual trauma issues, and
22	peer support specialists).
23	(b) Automatic Notification System.—In a claim
24	for compensation arising from military sexual trauma ex-
25	perienced by a veteran, if the veteran is enrolled in the
26	patient enrollment system of the Department of Veterans

1	Affairs under section 1705 of title 38, United States Code,
2	and consents to the notification system under this sub-
3	section, the Under Secretary for Benefits shall automati-
4	cally notify the Under Secretary for Health immediately
5	before and after the veteran—
6	(1) participates in any covered event; or
7	(2) receives any covered document.
8	(c) Definitions.—In this section:
9	(1) The term "compensation" has the meaning
10	given that term in section 101 of title 38, United
11	States Code.
12	(2) The term "covered document" means a de-
13	termination (including a rating determination) that
14	the Secretary of Veterans Affairs provides to the
15	claimant in connection with a claim for compensa-
16	tion.
17	(3) The term "covered event" includes, with re-
18	spect to a claim for compensation—
19	(A) a medical examination under section
20	5103A of title 38, United States Code;
21	(B) a hearing before the Board of Vet-
22	erans' Appeals under section 7107 of such title;
23	and
24	(C) any other event determined relevant by
25	the Secretary of Veterans Affairs.

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1	(4) The term "military sexual trauma" has the
2	meaning given that term in subsection (c) of the sec-
3	ond section 1164 of title 38, United States Code.
4	(5) The term "Veterans Crisis Line" means the
5	toll-free hotline for veterans established under sec-
6	tion 1720F(h) of title 38. United States Code.
