In 2004, Derek Fronabarger joined the Army and served as an Air Defense Intelligence Tactical Operator. Most of his time was spent overseas in Germany, Israel, and Afghanistan. He served in both the 82nd and 101st Airborne Division during deployments and obtained the rank of Sergeant before separating in 2008.

After the military, Mr. Fronabarger returned to Charleston and earned his B.A. in Philosophy and Anthropology at the College of Charleston.
