1	SECTION 1. FACT SHEETS REGARDING VA AND SOCIAL SE-
2	CURITY BENEFITS AND COMPENSATION.
3	(a) Establishment.—Not later than six months
4	after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary
5	of Veterans Affairs, after consultation with the Commis-
6	sioner of the Social Security Administration and stake-
7	holders (including veterans service organizations), shall
8	create a fact sheet, one for veterans and one for survivors
9	of deceased veterans, that compares, for such individ-
10	uals—
11	(1) benefits and compensation (including a pen-
12	sion) under laws administered by the Secretary;
13	(2) monthly insurance benefits under title II of
14	the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 401 et seq.); and
15	(3) supplemental security income under title
16	XVI of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1381 et
17	seq.).
18	(b) Elements.—A fact sheet created under sub-
19	section (a) shall include, with respect to such benefits and
20	compensation, monthly insurance benefits, and supple-

1	(c) Provision.—Not later than three months after
2	creating a fact sheet under subsection (a), the Secretary
3	shall provide a copy thereof to an individual whenever the
4	Secretary—
5	(1) receives from such individual—
6	(A) an initial claim for a benefit or com-
7	pensation; or
8	(B) a claim for an increase to a benefit or
9	compensation; or
10	(2) notifies such individual that the Secretary
11	has denied a claim for, or decreased the amount of,
12	a benefit or compensation.
13	(d) Annual Updates.—The Secretary shall update
14	a fact sheet created under subsection (a), to reflect
15	amendments to laws described in such subsection, not less
16	than once annually.
