

Tiffany M. Wagner was sworn in as Clerk of Court of the U.S. Court of Appeals for Veterans Claims by Chief Judge Margaret Bartley in a ceremonial session of the Court convened on November 28, 2023.

Ms. Wagner served in uniform for 21 years, having retired from active duty as a Colonel in the Air Force Judge Advocate General's Corps. Her military work spanned the legal spectrum, including being a prosecutor, defense counsel, supervisory attorney, and military trial judge as well as an advisor on operational and environmental law. In her last two assignments, she was the Executive Director for The Judge Advocate General and the Legal Director for the Air Force Review Boards Agency, where she led a team advising and supporting 12 Department of Defense and Department of the Air Force boards to ensure due process, fairness, and justice in administrative actions.

Ms. Wagner's education background includes an undergraduate degree from Purdue University, a master's degree from National War College, a law degree from Valparaiso University School of Law and an LL.M. from George Washington University Law School.
