AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 7816

OFFERED BY MR. LUTTRELL OF TEXAS

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Clear Communication3 for Veterans Claims Act".

4 SEC. 2. INDEPENDENT ASSESSMENT OF NOTICES THAT THE 5 SECRETARY OF VETERANS AFFAIRS SENDS 6 TO CLAIMANTS.

7 (a) AGREEMENT.—Not later than 30 days after the 8 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Vet-9 erans Affairs shall seek to enter into an agreement with 10 an FFRDC for an assessment of notices that the Sec-11 retary sends to claimants.

(b) ASSESSMENT.—An FFRDC that enters to an
agreement under subsection (a) shall submit to the Secretary a written assessment of such notices. The assessment shall include the following:

16 (1) The determination of the FFRDC, made in17 consultation with covered entities, whether each such

1	notice may be feasibly altered to reduce paper con-
2	sumption by, and costs to, the Federal Government.
3	(2) The recommendations of the FFRDC re-
4	garding how the Secretary may, in compliance with
5	laws administered by the Secretary, make such no-
6	tices clearer to claimants, better organized, and
7	more concise.
8	(c) Report; Implementation.—Not later than 90
9	days after the Secretary receives the assessment under
10	subsection (b), the Secretary shall—
11	(1) submit to the Committees on Veterans' Af-
12	fairs of the Senate and House of Representatives a
13	copy of such assessment; and
14	(2) implement the recommendations in the as-
15	sessment.
16	(d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:
17	(1) The term "FFRDC" means a federally
18	funded research and development center.
19	(2) The term "covered entities" includes—
20	(A) the Secretary of Veterans Affairs;
21	(B) an expert in laws administered by the
22	Secretary of Veterans Affairs;
23	(C) a veterans service organization recog-
24	nized under section 5902 of title 38, United
25	States Code; and

(D) an entity that advocates for veterans.
 (3) The terms "claimant" and "notice" have
 the meanings given such terms in section 5100 of
 title 38, United States Code.
