## A BILL

- To direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to report on expanding the use of certain automation tools in the Department of Veterans Affairs.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Modernizing All Vet-
- 5 erans and Survivors Claims Processing Act".

## SEC. 2. PLAN TO EXPAND USE OF AUTOMATION TOOLS TO PROCESS CLAIMS UNDER LAWS ADMINIS TERED BY THE SECRETARY OF VETERANS AF FAIRS.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, and twice annually 6 7 thereafter, the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall submit to the Committees on Veterans' Affairs of the Senate and 8 9 House of Representatives the plan of the Secretary to make available, to the maximum extent practicable, auto-10 mation tools described in subsection (b) to other subdivi-11 sions of the Department of Veterans Affairs, for the pur-12 13 pose of processing claims under laws administered by the 14 Secretary.

(b) AUTOMATION TOOLS DESCRIBED.—An automation tool described in this subsection is a technology developed for the Compensation Service of the Veterans Benefits Administration that—

- (1) automates the retrieval of the service recordor health records of a veteran;
- (2) compiles evidence relevant to the determination of a claim for benefits under laws administered
  by the Secretary;

24 (3) provides automated decision support rel-25 evant to such a determination;

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1	(4) automates information sharing between
2	Federal agencies; or
3	(5) assists in generating correspondence regard-
4	ing such a claim.
5	(c) ELEMENTS.—The plan under subsection (a) shall
6	include analyses of the following:
7	(1) The feasibility and benefits of the use of
8	such automation technologies by such subdivisions
9	for such purpose.
10	(2) Any modification to an automation tool that
11	may be necessary to make it usable by such a sub-
12	division.
13	(3) Any requirement of such a subdivision per-
14	taining to such purpose that cannot be addressed by
15	using such an automation tool.
16	(4) The extent to which the technology offices
17	of such subdivisions may need to collaborate with
18	the technology office responsible for developing such
19	an automation tool.
20	(5) A timeline for modifying and implementing
21	the use of such automation tools for such purpose.
22	(d) PRIORITY.—In carrying out subsection (a), the
23	Secretary shall give priority to the following subdivisions
24	of the Department:

1	(1) The Pension and Fiduciary Service of the
2	Veterans Benefits Administration.
3	(2) The Education Service of the Veterans Ben-
4	efits Administration.
5	(3) Program offices of the Veterans Benefits
6	Administration, as determined by the Secretary.
7	(4) The Debt Management Center.
8	(5) The Board of Veterans' Appeals.
