**A BILL**

To prevent the use of unconstitutional gun confiscation laws  
against veterans.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Safeguarding Veterans  
5 2nd Amendment Rights Act of 2024”.

6 **SEC. 2. PREVENTION OF USE OF UNCONSTITUTIONAL GUN**

7 **CONFISCATION LAWS AGAINST VETERANS.**

8 (a) PROHIBITION.—No officer or employee of the De-  
9 partment of Veterans Affairs shall, in the course of their

1 duties as an officer or employee of such Department, ini-  
2 tiate, participate in, or advocate for the removal of a fire-  
3 arm in any proceedings relating to a State gun confisca-  
4 tion law.

5 (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

6 (1) The term “gun confiscation law” means a  
7 State law that provides the authority for the removal  
8 of a firearm through a risk-based, temporary, and  
9 preemptive protective order.

10 (2) The term “State” has the meaning given  
11 such term in section 101 of title 38, United States  
12 Code.
