Nancy Springer is an Associate Director for the National Legislative Service of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States. Her portfolio covers legislative advocacy related to disability assistance and memorial affairs including toxic exposures.

Nancy's hometown is Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Entering the U.S. Naval Academy in July 1983, Nancy commissioned in the Marine Corps upon graduation in May 1987. During her 30-year career, Nancy served as a logistics officer throughout the United States and overseas. retirement from the Pentagon, Nancy worked as a defense contractor in support of the Intelligence Community, primarily at the National Geospatial Intelligence Agency.
