Acting Deputy Vice Chairman, Veterans Law Judge Board of Veterans' Appeals

Mr. Deichert was appointed to the position of Veterans Law Judge (VLJ) at the Board of Veterans' Appeals in October 2018. Prior to that time, he served as an attorney-advisor and as a Senior Counsel at the Board. As a VLJ, he issues decisions on behalf of the Secretary on Appeals of VA benefits claims, and he conducts hearings with Veterans and their representatives. Through Fiscal Year 2023, Mr. Deichert served as the Presiding Judge in the Office of the Clerk of the Board, answering jurisdictional questions regarding appeals governed by the modernized review system. He began his service as an Acting Deputy Vice Chairman in July 2024.
