CHARGE TO ENTITLEMENT FOR CERTAIN LICEN-2 SURE AND CERTIFICATION TESTS AND NA-3 TIONAL TESTS UNDER DEPARTMENT OF VET-4 ERANS AFFAIRS POST-9/11 EDUCATIONAL AS-5 SISTANCE PROGRAM. 6 (a) LICENSURE AND CERTIFICATION TESTS.—Sec-7 tion 3315(c) of title 38, United States Code, is amended by striking "shall be determined" and all that follows and 8 inserting "shall be pro-rated based on the actual amount 9 of the fee charged for the test". 10 11 (b) NATIONAL TESTS.—Section 3315A of such title 12 is amended— 13 (1) in subsection (a), by adding at the end the 14 following new paragraph: 15 "(3) A national test that evaluates prior learn-16 ing and knowledge and provides an opportunity for 17 course credit at an institution of higher learning as 18 so described."; and 19 (2) in subsection (c), by striking "shall be de-20 termined" and all that follows and inserting "shall 21 be pro-rated based on the actual amount of the fee 22 charged for the test".

(c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
this Act shall apply to a test taken after the date that
is 90 days after the date of the enactment of this Act.

22	SEC. 5. TRAINING FOR SCHOOL CERTIFYING OFFICIALS.
23	(a) TRAINING REQUIREMENT.—The Secretary of
24	Veterans Affairs shall provide for requirements relating to
25	training for school certifying officials employed by edu-
26	cational institutions offering courses of education ap-

proved under chapter 36 of title 38, United States Code.
 If an educational institution does not ensure that a school
 certifying official employed by the educational institution
 meets such requirements, the Secretary may disapprove
 any course of education offered by such educational insti tution.

7 (b) SCHOOL CERTIFYING OFFICIAL DEFINED.—In 8 this section, the term "school certifying official" means 9 an employee of an educational institution with primary re-10 sponsibility for certifying veteran enrollment at the edu-11 cational institution.

12SEC. 6. REDUCTION OF AMOUNT OF HOUSING STIPEND13PAYMENTS FOR REDUCTION OF COURSE14HOURS.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (i) of section 3313 of
title 38, United States Code, is amended to read as follows:

18 "(i) Determination of Housing Stipend Pay-19 ments.—

"(1) IN GENERAL.—Any monthly housing stipend payable under this section during the academic
year beginning on August 1 of a calendar year shall
be determined utilizing rates for basic allowances for
housing payable under section 403 of title 37 in effect as of January 1 of such calendar year.

1 "(2) REDUCTION IN CASES OF DROPPED CLASS-2 ES.—In the case of any individual who receives a 3 monthly housing stipend payable under this section 4 who reduces the number of course hours borne by 5 the individual after the beginning of an academic pe-6 riod, the Secretary shall reduce the amount of the 7 monthly housing stipend payable to the individual 8 accordingly on a pro rata basis. If the Secretary de-9 termines that an individual received a monthly hous-10 ing stipend at the beginning of a month and that the 11 individual reduced the number of course hours borne 12 by the individual such that the individual was not 13 entitled to the full amount of the payment received 14 for that month, the Secretary may reduce the 15 amount payable to the individual for the subsequent 16 month by an amount equal to the amount of the 17 overpayment.". 18 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by 19 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to a month that 20 begins on or after August 1, 2017. 21 SEC. 7. LIMITATION ON USE OF REPORTING FEES PAYABLE 22 TO EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS AND JOINT

APPRENTICESHIP TRAINING COMMITTEES.

24 Section 3684(c) of title 38, United States Code, is25 amended to read as follows:

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1 "(c)(1) The Secretary may pay to any educational in-2 stitution, or to the sponsor of a program of apprenticeship, furnishing education or training under either this chapter 3 4 or chapter 31, 34, or 35 of this title, a reporting fee which 5 will be in lieu of any other compensation or reimbursement for reports or certifications which such educational institu-6 7 tion or joint apprenticeship training committee is required 8 to submit to the Secretary by law or regulation.

9 "(2) Such reporting fee shall be computed for each calendar year by multiplying \$12 by the number of eligible 10 11 veterans or eligible persons enrolled under this chapter or 12 chapter 31, 34, or 35 of this title, or \$15 in the case of those eligible veterans and eligible persons whose edu-13 14 cational assistance checks are directed in care of each in-15 stitution for temporary custody and delivery and are deliv-16 ered at the time of registration as provided under section 17 3680(d)(4) of this title, during the calendar year. The reporting fee shall be paid to such educational institution 18 19 or joint apprenticeship training committee as soon as fea-20sible after the end of the calendar year for which it is 21 applicable.

"(3) No reporting fee payable to an educational institution under this subsection shall be subject to offset by
the Secretary against any liability of such institution for
any overpayment for which such institution may be admin-

istratively determined to be liable under section 3685 of
 this title unless such liability is not contested by such in stitution or has been upheld by a final decree of a court
 of appropriate jurisdiction.

5 "(4) Any reporting fee paid an educational institution
6 or joint apprenticeship training committee after the date
7 of the enactment of the Post-9/11 Veterans Educational
8 Assistance Improvements Act of 2011—

9 "(A) shall be utilized by such institution or 10 committee solely for the making of certifications re-11 quired under this chapter or chapter 31, 34, or 35 12 of this title or for otherwise supporting programs for 13 veterans; and

"(B) may not be used for or merged with
amounts available for the general fund of the educational institution or joint apprenticeship training
committee.

18 "(5) The reporting fee payable under this subsection19 shall be paid from amounts appropriated for readjustment20 benefits.".
