- To direct the Secretary of Labor to carry out a research program to evaluate the effectiveness of Transition Assistance Program in addressing needs of certain minority veterans
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1	SECTION 1. RESEARCH PROGRAM TO EVALUATE EFFEC-
2	TIVENESS OF TRANSITION ASSISTANCE PRO-
3	GRAM IN ADDRESSING NEEDS OF CERTAIN
4	MINORITY VETERANS.
5	(a) Research Program.—The Secretary of Labor,
6	in collaboration with the Secretary of Veterans Affairs and
7	the Secretary of Defense, shall carry out a research pro-
8	gram to evaluate the Transition Assistance Program
9	under section 1144 of title 10, United States Code. Such
10	research program shall be designed to determine how ef-
11	fectively the Transition Assistance Program addresses the
12	differentiated needs, challenges, and post-military service
13	aspirations of women veterans, veterans with disabilities,
14	Native American veterans, and other groups of minority
15	veterans identified by the Secretaries.
16	(b) Issues Addressed.—The Secretary of Labor
17	shall ensure that the research program required under
18	subsection (a) addresses each of the following issues:
19	(1) In the context of the transition experience,
20	whether and how the barriers to employment facing
21	women veteran, veterans with disabilities, Native
22	American veterans, and other identified groups of
23	minority veterans are substantively different from
24	other populations of the veteran community.
25	(2) In the context of the transition experience,
26	whether and how the post-military service employ-

1	ment aspirations such groups of veterans covered by
2	the research project are substantively different from
3	such aspirations of other populations of the veteran
4	community.
5	(3) To the extent that any barriers to employ-
6	ment or aspirations are identified under paragraph
7	(1) or (2) as being substantially different for any of
8	the groups of veterans covered by the research
9	project, whether the Transition Assistance Program
10	is designed to appropriately address those dif-
11	ferences.
12	(4) To the extent that the Transition Assist-
13	ance Program is determined not to be designed to
14	appropriately address a difference under paragraph
15	(3), an identification of any change that could be
16	made to the Program to more appropriately address
17	such difference.
18	(c) REPORT REQUIRED.—Not later than one year
19	after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary
20	of Labor shall submit to Congress a report on the research
21	program required under this section.
