

## Dan Penski Bio

Dan's career started in the Glazing Industry in 1974 as a Glassworker for Local Union #660 in Buffalo, New York. Dan worked as a Glassworker for five years, and then became an Apprentice Glazier. After completing his apprenticeship, he became a journeyman glazier and eventually a foreman for various glass companies that were signatory to Glaziers Local Union #660. In 1998 Dan became the Glazing Coordinator for L.U. #660 in Buffalo, and L.U. #677 Rochester New York, and eventually the Training Director for District Council #4. Dan was President of Glaziers Local Union #660 and held this position for 5 years until he went to work for the Finishing Trades Institute (FTI). Dan has been a member in good standing with LU#660 for 43 years.

In 2004 Dan went to work for the FTI and the Labor Management Cooperation Initiative (LMCI) performing many duties that included Health and Safety Coordinator, Industry Liaison of the Eastern Region, and Coordinator/Instructor of the LMCI Supervisor Training Program (STP).

In April 2007, the Finishing Trades Institute Board of Trustees appointed Dan the Director of the Finishing Trades Institute.
