

Colonel Dave Lewis, US Air Force (Retired) served 29 years on active duty and has commanded at the flight, operating location, flying squadron, and operations group levels. He has served in the European, Pacific, and Southwest Asian theaters, and his career included duties with the US Army, the US Naval War College as a faculty member, and commander of a foreign fighter squadron. He is a command pilot with over 3,100 flying hours in fighter and trainer aircraft. He has served our country in combat both on the ground and in the air.

Colonel Lewis retired from the Air Force in December 2009, with his last duty as Commander, Air Force ROTC Detachment 820 at Texas Tech. During his time at Tech he was instrumental in the creation of the Strategic Studies graduate certificate program, and now serves as the Director of the Strategic Studies program. He is an Assistant Professor of Practice in the Political Science Department, where he teaches courses on Strategy, Intelligence, Terrorism, National Security and Homeland Security. He is the President of the Veterans Resource Coordination Group, and the Director of Veteran Services for StarCare Specialty Health executing grants from the state of Texas and VA that provide services to transitioning veterans, including emergency financial assistance, homeless and justice-involved veterans programs.
