To direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to study the link between certain economic factors and veteran suicides.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "VA Economic Hard-5 ship Report Act".

6 SEC. 2. STUDY ON ECONOMIC FACTORS CONTRIBUTING TO 7 VETERAN SUICIDES.

8 (a) COMPILATION OF DATA.—Not later than one year

9 fter the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary

of Veterans Affairs shall submit to the Committee on Vet-1 2 erans' Affairs a report on the economic factors that con-3 tribute to veteran suicides. Such report shall include each 4 of the following for the one-year period preceding the date 5 of the enactment of this Act: 6 (1) The number of homeless veterans. 7 (2) The number of veterans who are housing in-8 secure. 9 (3) The number of veterans living in poverty. 10 (4) The number of veterans who are food inse-11 cure. 12 (5) The number of veterans who earn at or 13 below minimum wage. 14 (6) The number of veterans who have com-15 mitted or attempted to commit suicide and who are, 16 or were at the time of such suicide or attempted sui-17 cide, homeless, in poverty, or food insecure. 18 (b) STUDY.—Not later than 180 days after submit-19 ting the report required by subsection (a), the Secretary 20 of Veterans Affairs shall conduct a study on the link be-21 tween poverty, food insecurity, housing insecurity, and vet-22 eran suicide.
