SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

1	SEC. 2. IMPROVEMENTS TO GRANTS AND AGREEMENTS BE-

13	SEC. 4. CONTRACTING FOR HUD-VASH CASE MANAGERS.
14	(a) In General.—Section 304 of the Honoring
15	America's Veterans and Caring for Camp Lejeune Fami-
16	lies Act of 2012 (Public Law 112–154; 38 U.S.C. 2041
17	note) is amended—
18	(1) in subsection (a)—
19	(A) by inserting "(1)" before "The Sec-
20	retary'';
21	(B) by adding at the end the following new
22	paragraphs:
23	"(2)(A) Subject to subparagraphs (B) and (C), the
24	director of a covered medical center shall seek to enter
25	into a contract or agreement described in paragraph (1).

1	"(B) A contract or agreement under subparagraph
2	(A) may not require that a case manager employed by an
3	eligible entity have credentials equivalent to those of a case
4	manager of the Department.
5	"(C) The Secretary may waive the requirement under
6	subparagraph (A) if the Secretary determines that ful-
7	filling such requirement is infeasible. If the Secretary
8	grants such a waiver, the Secretary shall submit, not later
9	than 90 days after granting such waiver, to the Commit-
10	tees on Veterans' Affairs of the Senate and House of Rep-
11	resentatives, a report containing—
12	"(i) an explanation of that determination;
13	"(ii) a plan to increase the number of case
14	managers of the Department; and
15	"(iii) a plan for the covered medical center to
16	increase use of such vouchers.
17	"(D) In this paragraph, the term 'covered medical
18	center' means a medical center of the Department that
19	the Secretary determines—
20	"(i) had more than 15 percent of vouchers allo-

24	of case management services provided by the Sec-

2	vacant for at least nine consecutive months imme-

4	"(3) The Secretary shall pay for contracts or agree-
5	ments under this subsection from amounts appropriated
6	or otherwise made available to the Secretary in the Med-
7	ical Services account."; and
8	(2) in subsection $(b)(2)$ —
9	(A) in the matter before subparagraph (A),
10	by striking ", including because—" and insert-
11	ing a period; and
12	(B) by striking subparagraphs (A), (B),
13	and (C).
14	(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
15	this section shall take effect on the first day of the first
16	fiscal year to begin on or after the date of the enactment
17	of this Act.
