1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	[SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the " Act".

1	SEC. 2. AUTHORITY OF THE SECRETARY OF VETERANS AF-
2	FAIRS TO PROVIDE OR ASSIST IN PROVIDING
3	ADDITIONAL VEHICLES ADAPTED FOR OPER-
4	ATION BY DISABLED INDIVIDUALS TO CER-
5	TAIN ELIGIBLE PERSONS.
6	(a) In General.—Section 3903(a) of title 38,
7	United States Code, is amended—
8	(1) in paragraph (1), by striking "paragraph
9	(2)" and inserting "paragraphs (2) and (3)"; and
10	(2) by adding at the end the following new
11	paragraph:
12	"(3) The Secretary may provide or assist in providing
13	an eligible person with an additional automobile or other
14	conveyance under this chapter if 10 years have elapsed
15	since the date on which the eligible person received the
16	immediately previous such automobile, other conveyance,
17	or assistance under this chapter.".
18	(b) Effective Date.—Paragraph (3) of subsection
19	(a) of section 3903 of title 38, United States Code, shall
20	apply with respect to the provision of an additional auto-
21	mobile or other conveyance that occurs on or after October
22	1, 2020.

1	SEC. 3. DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS PROVISION
2	OF AUTOMOBILES AND ADAPTIVE ASSIST-
3	ANCE FOR VETERANS WITH NON-SERVICE-
4	CONNECTED DISABILITIES.
5	(a) In General.—Chapter 39 of title 38, United
6	States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
7	lowing new section:
8	" \S 3905. Assistance for veterans with non-service-con-
9	nected disabilities
10	"(a) In General.—The Secretary, under regula-
11	tions which the Secretary shall prescribe, shall provide or
12	assist in providing an automobile or other conveyance to
13	each eligible veteran with a non-service-connected dis-
14	ability by paying 25 percent of the total purchase price
15	of the automobile or other conveyance (including all State,
16	local, and other taxes) or $$5,372.07$ (as adjusted from
17	time to time under subsection (f)), whichever is the lesser,
18	to the seller from whom the eligible veteran is purchasing
19	under a sales agreement between the seller and the eligible
20	person.
21	"(b) ADAPTIVE EQUIPMENT.—The Secretary, under
22	regulations which the Secretary shall prescribe, shall pro-
23	vide each eligible veteran with a non-service-connected dis-
24	ability the adaptive equipment deemed necessary to insure
25	that the eligible veteran will be able to operate the auto-
26	mobile or other conveyance in a manner consistent with

1	such veteran's own safety and the safety of others and
2	so as to satisfy the applicable standards of licensure estab-
3	lished by the State of such veteran's residency or other
4	proper licensing authority.
5	"(c) Repair and Replacement of Equipment.—
6	In accordance with regulations which the Secretary shall
7	prescribe, the Secretary shall—
8	"(1) repair, replace, or reinstall adaptive equip-
9	ment deemed necessary for the operation of an auto-
10	mobile or other conveyance acquired in accordance
11	with the provisions of this chapter; and
12	"(2) provide, repair, replace, or reinstall such
13	adaptive equipment for any automobile or other con-
14	veyance which an eligible veteran with a non-service-
15	connected disability may previously or subsequently
16	have acquired.
17	"(d) Automobiles Operated by Other Per-
18	sons.—If an eligible veteran with a non-service-connected
19	disability cannot qualify to operate an automobile or other
20	conveyance, the Secretary shall provide or assist in pro-
21	viding an automobile or other conveyance to such veteran,
22	as provided in subsection (a), if the automobile or other
23	conveyance is to be operated for the eligible veteran by
24	another person.

1	"(e) Eligible Veteran With a Non-service-con-
2	NECTED DISABILITY.—In this section, the term 'eligible
3	veteran with a non-service-connected disability' means a
4	veteran who—
5	"(1) the Secretary determines has—
6	"(A) the loss or permanent loss of use of
7	one or both feet;
8	"(B) the loss or permanent loss of use of
9	one or both hands;
10	"(C) the permanent impairment of vision
11	of both eyes of the following status: central vis-
12	ual acuity of 20/200 or less in the better eye,
13	with corrective glasses, or central visual acuity
14	of more than $20/200$ if there is a field defect
15	in which the peripheral field has contracted to
16	such an extent that the widest diameter of vis-
17	ual field subtends an angular distance no great-
18	er than twenty degrees in the better eye; or
19	"(D) a severe burn injury (as determined
20	pursuant to regulations prescribed by the Sec-
21	retary); and
22	"(2) is not in receipt of compensation under
23	chapter 11 of this title for a disability referred to in
24	paragraph (1).

1	"(f) Annual Adjustment.—Effective on October 1
2	of each year (beginning in 2021), the Secretary shall in-
3	crease the dollar amount in effect under subsection (a)
4	by a percentage equal to the percentage by which the Con-
5	sumer Price Index for all urban consumers (U.S. city aver-
6	age) increased during the 12-month period ending with
7	the last month for which Consumer Price Index data is
8	available. In the event that such Consumer Price Index
9	does not increase during such period, the Secretary shall
10	maintain the dollar amount in effect under subsection (a)
11	during the previous fiscal year.".
12	(b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
13	at the beginning of such chapter is amended by adding
14	at the end the following new item:
	"3905. Assistance for veterans with non-service-connected disabilities.".
15	SEC. 4. DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS TREATMENT
16	OF CERTAIN VEHICLE MODIFICATIONS AS
17	MEDICAL SERVICES.
18	Section 1701(6) of title 38, United States Code, is
19	amended by adding at the end the following new subpara-
20	graph:
21	"(I) The provision of medically necessary
22	van lifts, raised doors, raised roofs, air-condi-
23	tioning, and wheelchair tiedowns for passenger
24	use.''.
