Keith Harris is a Clinical Psychologist who currently serves as National Director of Clinical Operations in the Homeless Program Office for the Department of Veterans Affairs where he provides guidance and oversight to the clinical programs in the Homeless Program continuum of the Veterans Health Administration. Programs under his direction include more than 4K employees providing outreach, case management, vocational services, residential housing, and permanent supportive housing to more than 200K homeless and at-risk Veterans each year. He oversees an operational analytics team that manages performance measurement, statistical modeling, and operational planning within VA

homeless program services and is responsible for ensuring quality, effectiveness, and efficiency across programs and sites. In addition, he serves as a VA national leader in federal and nonprofit interagency efforts to end Veteran homelessness, such as the recent 25 Cities Initiative, and Built for Zero. Prior to joining VA Central Office, Dr. Harris served as the director of homeless programs at the VA Palo Alto Healthcare System where he oversaw the full continuum of homeless services which were honored with the VA Secretary's Award for Outstanding Achievement in Service to Homeless Veterans during his tenure.
