1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “_____ Act
5 of 2021”.

6 **SEC. 2. ADJUSTMENTS OF GRANTS AWARDED BY THE SEC-**
7 **RETARY OF VETERANS AFFAIRS FOR COM-**
8 **PREHENSIVE SERVICE PROGRAMS TO SERVE**
9 **HOMELESS VETERANS.**

10 (a) **ELIMINATION OF MATCHING REQUIREMENT.—**

1 (1) IN GENERAL.—Section 2011(e) of title 38,
2 United States Codes, is amended—

3 (A) by striking paragraph (2); and

4 (B) by redesignating paragraph (3) as
5 paragraph (2).

6 (2) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made
7 by paragraph (1) shall apply with respect to any
8 grant awarded under section 2011 of title 38,
9 United States Code, on or after the date of the en-
10 actment of this Act.

11 (3) DETERMINATION OF AMOUNT OF GRANT.—
12 On or after the date that is five years after the date
13 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Vet-
14 erans Affairs may determine the maximum amount
15 of a grant under section 2011 of title 38, United
16 States Code, which shall be not less than 70 percent
17 of the estimated cost of the project concerned.

18 (4) SUNSET.—Section 4201(b)(2) of the John-
19 ny Isakson and David P. Roe, M.D. Veterans Health
20 Care and Benefits Improvement Act of 2020 (Public
21 Law 116–315; 134 Stat. 5009; 38 U.S.C. 2011
22 note) is amended—

23 (A) by striking “Subsection (e)(2)” and in-
24 serting the following:

1 “(A) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (c)(2)”;

2 and

3 (B) by adding at the end the following new
4 subparagraph:

5 “(B) SUNSET.—Subparagraph (A) shall
6 cease to be effective on the date of the enact-
7 ment of the Building Solutions for Veterans
8 Experiencing Homelessness Act of 2021.”.

9 (b) ELIMINATION OF PROPERTY DISPOSITION RE-
10 QUIREMENTS.—

11 (1) IN GENERAL.—A recipient of a grant
12 awarded under section 2011 of title 38, United
13 States Code, on or after the date of the enactment
14 of this Act for a project described in subsection
15 (b)(1) of such section shall not be subject to any
16 property disposition requirements relating to the
17 grant under subsection (c) or (f) of section 61.67 of
18 title 38, Code of Federal Regulations, section
19 200.311(e) of title 2, Code of Federal Regulations,
20 or successor regulations.

21 (2) SUNSET.—Section 4201(b)(6) of the John-
22 ny Isakson and David P. Roe, M.D. Veterans Health
23 Care and Benefits Improvement Act of 2020 (Public
24 Law 116–315; 134 Stat. 5010; 38 U.S.C. 2011
25 note) is amended—

1 (A) by striking “During” and inserting the
2 following:

3 “(A) IN GENERAL.—During”; and

4 (B) by adding at the end the following new
5 subparagraph:

6 “(B) SUNSET.—Subparagraph (A) shall
7 cease to be effective on the date of the enact-
8 ment of the Building Solutions for Veterans
9 Experiencing Homelessness Act of 2021.”.
