1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Protect Military De-  
3 pendants Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. SOLE LIABILITY FOR TRANSFERRED EDUCATIONAL**  
5 **ASSISTANCE BY AN INDIVIDUAL WHO FAILS**  
6 **TO COMPLETE A SERVICE AGREEMENT.**

7 Subsection (i) of section 3319 of title 38, United  
8 States Code, is amended—

9 (1) in paragraph (1)—

10 (A) by striking “In the event” and insert-  
11 ing “Subject to paragraph (2), in the event”;  
12 and

13 (B) by inserting “of this title” after “sec-  
14 tion 3685”;

15 (2) in subparagraph (A) of paragraph (2)—

16 (A) in the heading, by striking “IN GEN-  
17 ERAL” and inserting “SOLE LIABILITY”; and

18 (B) by inserting “for which the individual  
19 shall be solely liable to the United States for  
20 the amount of the overpayment for purposes of  
21 section 3685 of this title” before the period at  
22 the end; and

23 (3) in subparagraph (B) of paragraph (2)—

24 (A) in the matter preceding clause (i), by  
25 striking “Subparagraph (A) shall not apply”  
26 and inserting “Neither the individual nor the

1 dependent shall be liable to the United States  
2 for the amount of the overpayment for purposes  
3 of section 3685 of this title”; and

4 (B) in clause (ii), by inserting “of this  
5 title” after “section 3311(c)(4)”.
