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1 "(A) the availability of mental health serv-2 ices furnished by the Secretary concerned, the 3 Secretary of Defense, the Secretary of Veterans 4 Affairs, or a non-profit entity; 5 "(B) the treatment of post-traumatic

6 stress disorder, traumatic brain injury, anxiety disorders, depression, chronic pain, sleep dis-8 orders, suicidal ideation, or other mental health 9 conditions associated with service in the armed 10 forces;

"(C) the risk of suicide, including signs, 11 12 symptoms, and risk factors (including adverse 13 childhood experiences, depression, bipolar dis-14 order, homelessness, unemployment, and rela-15 tionship strain);

"(D) the availability of treatment options and resources to address substance abuse, including alcohol, prescription drug, and opioid abuse;

20 "(E) the potential effects of the loss of 21 community and support systems experienced by 22 a member separating from the armed forces;

23 "(F) isolation from family, friends, or soci-24 ety; and

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1	"(G) the potential stressors associated with
2	separation from the armed forces.".
3	(b) Solid Start Program of the Department
4	OF VETERANS AFFAIRS.—Section 6320(b)(1) of title 38,
5	United States Code, is amended—
6	(1) by redesignating subparagraphs (G) and
7	(H) as subparagraphs (I) and (J), respectively; and
8	(2) by inserting after subparagraph (F) the fol-
9	lowing new subparagraphs:
10	"(G) assisting eligible veterans who elect to en-
11	roll in the system of patient enrollment under sec-
12	tion 1705(a) of this title;
13	"(H) educating veterans about mental health
14	and counseling services available through the Vet-
15	erans Health Administration;".
16	(c) REPORT.—Not later than one year after the date
