Dr. Ellzy provides strategic clinical direction for Oracle's federal business including the Department of Veterans Administration, Department of Defense (DoD), US Coast Guard, and Center for Disease Control. He leads the development of the vision and strategy for the largest healthcare transformation in history.

Prior to joining Oracle Cerner, Dr. Ellzy completed 26 years of federal service, with 22 years in active military service and the last four as a civilian. His civilian position was as the MHS GENESIS Clinical Functional Champion where he was instrumental in the rollout of Cerner in the DoD. He advised and assisted Defense Health Agency (DHA) leadership on all matters pertaining to MHS GENESIS as it applied to clinical policy and procedures. These duties included collaborating with the Veterans Health Administration.

Dr. Ellzy retired from the United States Navy December 2018. Some highlights of his active-duty time include Chief Medical Informatics Officer (CMIO) for Navy Medicine; Family Medicine Department Chief at Fort Belvoir Community Hospital (where he introduced the first Navy residents into then DeWitt Army Community Hospital); and Director of Clinical Quality in the Office of Chief Medical Officer at TRICARE Management Activity (the predecessor to the DHA). He completed four deployments aboard Navy amphibious ships.

Dr. Ellzy received his Medical Doctorate from the East Tennessee State University James H. Quillen College of Medicine. He received his Master in Medical Informatics and Bachelor of Arts in Computer Studies from Northwestern University. Dr. Ellzy is a Fellow in the American Academy of Family Physicians and served on their board of directors for three years. He earned his certification in Medical Quality from the American Board of Medical Quality.
