Dr. Zomchek was appointed Veterans Integrated Service Network (VISN) 12 Director on September 25, 2022. In this role, he oversees 8 medical centers, 40 outpatient clinics, 8 nursing homes, and 7 domiciliaries, offering health care services to almost 800,000 Veterans who reside in its 4-state (Illinois, Wisconsin, Michigan's Upper Peninsula and Northwest Indiana) area. Prior to assuming the Network Director role, Dr. Zomchek served as the Acting VISN 12 Network Director beginning in May 2022, and as the Director of the Clement J. Zablocki VA Medical Center in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, where he oversaw the delivery of health care to more than 107K Veterans and was responsible for an operating budget of \$730M and a workforce of approximately 4,100 personnel.

Previously, Dr. Zomchek also served as the Associate Director of the Edward Hines Jr. VA Medical Center and the Associate Director at the Edith Nourse Rogers Memorial VA Medical Center in Bedford, Massachusetts. Additionally, he served as a Health Systems Specialist for the Veterans Integrated Service Network of Ohio (VISN 10), where he managed various programs and initiatives across a network of five medical centers. While in his position at VISN 10, Dr. Zomchek served as Acting Associate Director of the Iron Mountain VA Medical Center in Iron Mountain, Michigan and as Acting Sub-Initiative Lead for one of the Secretary's Major Transformation Initiatives.

Dr. Zomchek is a Certified Mentor and is board certified in Healthcare Management as a Fellow of the American College of Healthcare Executives.
