Mike Reeve is the Director of Veterans Affairs for Shiawassee County, where he is committed to serving those who have served. Under his leadership since 2018, the Veterans Affairs Department has assisted **12,147** Veterans and brought more than **\$260 million** in benefits and services to Shiawassee County.

A CAREER OF SERVICE AND LEADERSHIP

Mike's dedication to service spans more than three decades. He proudly served in the United States Army for 27 years, retiring with the rank of Major. During his distinguished military career, he served as a Field Artillery Officer and held a variety of leadership positions of increasing responsibility. He also had assignments with two Counter-Narcotics, Terrorism Teams in the Special Operations community.

As a Division Effects Chief, Mike supervised and managed over 500 community relations events in 11 counties of coastal Georgia. These events included visits by Ambassadors, Department of the Army VIPs, Congressional and Senatorial Members, and even the President of the United States, Barack Obama.

He also served as Deputy Director of Logistics, where he played an instrumental role in developing a Maintenance Transition Plan and establishing the first-ever Service-Support School for the Iraqi Special Forces (ISOF) units in five provinces throughout Iraq.

Throughout his Army career, Mike demonstrated exceptional leadership, strategic thinking, and a commitment to mission success. His experience in operations, logistics, and community engagement shaped his ability to bring people together and solve complex problems—skills he continues to apply every day in service to Shiawassee County Veterans.
