

### **Amendment Offered by Mr. McDermott of Washington**

The amendment would require 501(c)(4) organizations to indicate whether they plan to engage in political activity or file reports with the Federal Election Commission.

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE  
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 1295  
OFFERED BY MR. McDERMOTT OF WASHINGTON**

At the end of section 506(b) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as proposed to be added by section 2(a) of the bill, add the following:

1           “(4) A statement indicating whether the organi-  
2           zation has or plans to participate in, or intervene in  
3           (including through the publishing or distributing of  
4           statements), a political campaign on behalf of, or in  
5           opposition to, any candidate for public office.

6           “(5) A statement indicating whether the organi-  
7           zation has filed, or was or anticipates being required  
8           to file, a statement or report under subsection (c) or  
9           (g) of section 304 of the Federal Election Campaign  
10          Act of 1974 with respect to independent expendi-  
11          tures.

12          “(6) A statement indicating whether the organi-  
13          zation has filed, or was or anticipates being required  
14          to file, a statement under section 304(f) of the such  
15          Act with respect to disbursements for electioneering  
16          communications.”.
