

## VOTES OF THE COMMITTEE

In compliance with the Rules of the House of Representatives, the following statement is made concerning the vote of the Committee on Ways and Means during the markup consideration of H.R. 1890, the “Bipartisan Congressional Trade Priorities and Accountability Act of 2015,” on April 23, 2015.

The vote on the amendment by Ms. Sanchez to H.R. 1890, which would restrict TPA procedures from being applied to trade agreements with any party that has a penal case punishing the LGBT community, was not agreed to by a roll call vote of 22 nays to 15 yeas (with a quorum being present). The vote was as follows:
