Amendment Offered by Mr. Lewis of Georgia

This amendment would delay the effective date of all revenue-reducing provisions in H.R. 1 until the United States withdraws from current wars in Afghanistan, Iraq, and Syria, and the deficit is zero.

At the appropriate place, insert the following new section:

1	SEC DELAYED APPLICATION OF PROVISIONS.
2	(a) In General.—None of the provisions described
3	in subsection (b) shall apply with respect to any taxable

6	(b) Provisions Described.—The provisions de-
7	scribed in this subsection are provisions enacted by this
8	Act that have the effect of lowering revenues below the
9	level projected for the corresponding time period in the
0	most recent Congressional Budget Office revenue baseline,
1	as determined by the Department of the Treasury.
12	(c) DATE DESCRIBED.—The date described in this
13	subsection is the date on which—
14	(1) the Armed Forces have been withdrawn
15	from all hostilities in Afghanistan, Iraq, and Syria;

1	(2) the amount of the Federal deficit for the
2	previous fiscal year as reported by the Congressional
3	Budget Office is not greater than zero.
