5 (a) ACTION PLAN.—The Secretary of Health and 6 Human Services, shall develop an action plan, in consulta-7 tion with stakeholders such as health care providers, in-8 surers, manufacturers, and patient advocates (including 9 relevant Federal advisory committees and Federal agen-10 cies), that—

(1) utilizes data from Medicare claims on how
much of a single-use drug was not administered,
comparing single-use vial sizes in other settings such
as to other countries' health care systems, and
through analysis during the drug approval process of
alternative vial size safety and efficacy, to reduce
drug waste and better manage costs;

1 (2) includes quantifiable metrics and specific 2 timelines to adopt different vial sizes in addition to 3 those currently approved and marketed in the 4 United States in order to significantly reduce the 5 amount of drug discards, or waste, from single-use 6 vials; and

7 (3) includes options for how to better manage
8 costs, including new technologies related to capture
9 and storage, while ensuring patient access and safe10 ty.

(b) REPORT.—Not later than 18 months after the
date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Health and
Human Services shall submit to Congress the action plan
described in subsection (a) and a report containing options
for any legislative action needed to reduce drug waste and
better manage costs.
