

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE  
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 3414  
OFFERED BY MR. Estes**

In the paragraph (9) proposed to be added by section 2(a)(4), add at the end the following new subparagraph:

- 1                   “(K) REPORTING REQUIREMENTS.—
- 2                   “ (i) IN GENERAL.—In the case of a
- 3                   hospital that receives any increase in the
- 4                   otherwise applicable resident limit under
- 5                   this paragraph for a cost reporting period,
- 6                   for such period and each succeeding cost
- 7                   reporting period, such hospital shall submit
- 8                   to the Secretary a report containing the in-
- 9                   formation described in clause (ii).
- 10                  “(ii) INFORMATION REQUIRED TO BE
- 11                  INCLUDED IN REPORT.—The information
- 12                  described in this clause is, with respect to
- 13                  a hospital with an approved medical resi-
- 14                  dency training program, a cost reporting
- 15                  period, and full-time-equivalent resident
- 16                  positions made available under this para-
- 17                  graph, the following:

1 “(I) The types of such programs  
2 that such hospital used such positions  
3 for during such period.

4 “(II) The number of such posi-  
5 tions under each such program.

6 “(III) The number of instances  
7 residents filling such positions treated  
8 individuals for a substance-use dis-  
9 order during such period.

10 “(IV) The number of such resi-  
11 dents who trained in rural areas (as  
12 defined in subsection (d)(2)(D)) dur-  
13 ing such period, including a list of  
14 each facility where such residents so  
15 trained.

16 “(V) The number of such resi-  
17 dents who trained in a health profes-  
18 sional shortage area with a designa-  
19 tion in effect under section 332 of the  
20 such Act during such period, includ-  
21 ing a list of each facility where such  
22 residents so trained.

23 “(VI) The number of such resi-  
24 dents who completed their residency  
25 training during such period and care

1 for vulnerable populations living in  
2 underserved areas.

3 “(VII) Of the number of such  
4 residents who completed their resi-  
5 dency training during such period, the  
6 number and percentage of such resi-  
7 dents who entered practice at a health  
8 care facility—

9 “(aa) primarily serving a  
10 health professional shortage area  
11 with a designation in effect under  
12 section 332 of the such Act or a  
13 medically underserved community  
14 (as defined in section 799B of  
15 such Act); or

16 “(bb) located in a rural area  
17 (as defined in subsection  
18 (d)(2)(D)).

19 “(VIII) Other information deter-  
20 mined appropriate by the Secretary  
21 that is required to be reported under  
22 graduate medical education programs  
23 under other Federal health care pro-  
24 grams (as defined in section 1128B)  
25 in order to promote alignment with

1 reporting under this subparagraph  
2 with reporting under such other pro-  
3 grams, taking into account any rec-  
4 ommendations made by the Comp-  
5 troller General of the United States.

6 “(iii) FAILURE TO REPORT.—In the  
7 case of a hospital described in clause (i)  
8 that fails submit a report for a cost report-  
9 ing period in accordance with such sub-  
10 paragraph, any payment made under this  
11 subsection with respect to such period to  
12 such hospital shall be reduced by 5 per-  
13 cent.”.
