

III. VOTES OF THE COMMITTEE

Pursuant to clause 3(b) of rule XIII of the Rules of the House of Representatives, the following statement is made concerning the vote of the Committee on Ways and Means during the consideration of H.R. 5825, “To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to provide for reporting by certain investors with respect to certain specified medical care providers” on February 12, 2020.

An amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute offered by Representative Brady, which would increase reporting on acquisitions to more parties, was defeated by a voice vote (with a quorum being present).

An amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute offered by Representative Doggett, which would grant authority to require transparency for certain persons owning assets used by specified medical care providers, was agreed to by voice vote (with a quorum being present).

An amendment in the nature of a substitute was agreed to by voice vote (with a quorum being present).

H.R. 5825, as amended by the amendment in the nature of a substitute, was ordered favorably reported to the House of Representatives by voice vote (with a quorum being present).
