Biography

Marlo Oaks is Utah's 26th State Treasurer. He was appointed in July 2021 and then elected in November 2022 to finish his predecessor's term. Marlo spent most of his career in money management and is one of only two state treasurers with institutional investment management experience. As the state's chief investment and chief banking officer, Marlo is responsible for debt, cash, and investments, including the \$31 billion Public Treasurer's Investment Fund. He also administers Utah's Unclaimed Property Division.

Because of Marlo's knowledge of the capital markets, he is leading the national charge against an alternate economic system benignly called ESG, short for Environmental, Social, and Governance. He has appeared on national programs, including Glenn Beck, Fox and Friends, and Tucker Carlson, and written articles for The Wall Street Journal, The Daily Wire, and The Daily Mail in the UK, among other outlets.

Marlo spent 17 years overseeing multi-billion-dollar investment portfolios. He is one of only two state treasurers with institutional investment experience. Marlo completed a Bachelor's degree in Economics from BYU, an MBA from UCLA Anderson, and holds the CFA and CAIA investment designations. He and his wife, Elaine, reside in Bountiful, Utah and are the parents of six children.
