Lauren Miller, from Dallas, was hospitalized at eight weeks of pregnancy for severe nausea, vomiting, and dehydration, and was diagnosed with hyperemesis gravidarum. She also learned at that time she was pregnant with twins. At 12 weeks, Lauren learned that one of her twins had trisomy 18—a condition that causes multiple structural abnormalities and makes the fetus unlikely to survive to birth. Due to Texas state laws, doctors denied Lauren’s abortion procedure. After being hospitalized for hyperemesis gravidarum at 15 weeks, she traveled out of state to Colorado to obtain the abortion.
