Gail Boudreaux is an American health insurance executive who currently serves as the President and CEO of Elevance Health, a position she has held since 2017. Elevance is one of the largest health care insurers in the United States, with 39 million members and drawing \$175 billion in annual revenue as of 2025. Elevance Health has numerous subsidiaries within its integrated structure, including Anthem, CarelonRX, and Carelon Health.

A graduate of Dartmouth College and Columbia Business School, Boudreaux started her career working at Aetna, where she rose to the role of Senior Vice President of Group Insurance throughout her 20-year tenure. She then went on to serve as Executive Vice President for External Operations at Blue Cross Blue Shield of Illinois, working in that capacity for 6 years before moving to United Healthcare where she worked as President then CEO. She has regularly been listed on Fortune and Forbes as one of the Most Powerful Women in Business. She has also been named on Modern Healthcare's list of the 100 Most Influential People in Healthcare. In addition to her role at Elevance, Boudreaux serves on the board of Target, the Central Indiana Corporate Partnership, Blue Cross Blue Shield Association, American Health Insurance Plans, and the Business Council.
