#### **Background**

Scott Walter is currently the President of Capital Research Center. Before that, he served in the George W. Bush Administration as Special Assistant to the President for Domestic Policy and was Vice President at the Philanthropy Roundtable. Mr. Walter has testified in front of six Committees in Congress – including Ways and Means – and has testified to the IRS and numerous state legislatures as well. Mr. Walter has been quoted in the *New York Times*, *Washington Post*, and *Wall Street Journal*, and the *Chronicle of Philanthropy*.

In his tenure with Capital Research Center, Scott has dedicated much of his time to investigating foreign influence in nonprofits intended to promote an anti-American agenda, incite violence and harassment, and spur antisemitism. He is very familiar with the methods through which nonprofits funnel taxpayer dollars into foreign countries.
