Background

Sam Hazen is Chief Executive Officer of HCA Healthcare, one of the nation's leading providers of health care services. HCA Healthcare covers 186 hospitals and approximately 2,400 ambulatory sites of care, including surgery centers, freestanding ERs, urgent care centers and physician clinics, which span 20 states and the United Kingdom. Based in Nashville, Tennessee, HCA Healthcare and its 275,000 employees provide approximately six percent of all U.S. inpatient hospital services.

A 41-year veteran of HCA Healthcare, Mr. Hazen was appointed CEO in 2019 after serving as President and Chief Operating Officer since 2016. Earlier, he served as President of Operations from 2011 to 2015. From 2001 to 2010, Hazen led HCA Healthcare's Western Group as President, and oversaw all operations west of the Mississippi River, which accounted for approximately half of the company's revenue.

Hazen currently serves on the Board of Directors for the Nashville Health Care Council, Federation of American Hospitals, and the HCA Healthcare Foundation.

Hazen earned his bachelor's degree in finance from the University of Kentucky and his master's degree in business administration from the University of Nevada Las Vegas.
